



Seven Creeks Action Plan

Fact Sheet 1 – Introduction to the Project

The Goulburn Broken Catchment Management Authority in partnership with the local community is developing a local Action Plan for the mid reaches of Seven Creeks (from Strathbogie to Polly McQuinns and including the lower reach of Spring Creek).

What will be covered in the Action Plan?

The Action Plan will:

- identify what attributes of Seven Creeks are highly valued by stakeholders;
- develop a preliminary set of goals (aspirational) relevant to these high value attributes;
- determine specific ecological processes and ecosystem structures of Seven Creeks that support/sustain particular high value attributes;
- identify threats (existing and potential) to the high value attributes of Seven Creeks;
- set objectives and targets to achieve the goals; and
- develop a priority works program that details:
 - specific activities required;
 - timeframe (begin and end) to undertake activities;
 - responsibilities; and
 - costs/inputs.

How will we present the Action Plan?

The Action Plan will be presented as a series of factsheets covering the following topics:

3. High Value Attributes
4. Threats
5. Priority Works Program
