MOUNT WOMBAT

A 360° Views to Shepparton and back across the Alps Road access almost to the top. Fire watching station (great place for a picnic, exploring, wildflowers and bird watching).

COLDER MOUNT

C Height 1028m on the south east side of the plateau. Superb views across to Bonnie Doon. Snow Gum Forest. Sight of old Gold Mining Town Tallangalook. Open cut mining area. The township has completely disappeared but is interesting that this town once had over 800 people living there. If you like looking for some history this is the place to visit

POLLY McQUINNINS

D Popular picnic spot if you are not afraid of ghosts Legend has it that Polly McQuinn drowned here when returning from a happy night at the Strathbogie Hotel Swimming, hiking, rock climbing, bird watching or just enjoying a BBQ.

GOORAM FALLS

E Go on down past Polly McQuinnins on the very scenic Galls Gap Rd turning left towards Merton, the beautiful cascading falls are well worth a visit picnic area and toilets. Great rock climbing and hiking area.

CRYSTAL MINES

F At the Crystal King mines good quality quartz and crystals were obtained until about 1940, there are some new claims there and a number of old shafts.

FOREST HILLS

G Ken and Helen Dunnachie's garden on the James Rd are truly beautiful. Open by appointment and on special occasions during Spring and Autumn

ROCKY NEB

H Very scenic area off Chinamans or Leasons Tracks Picnic areas rock climbing, waterfalls all to be found in this area.
