



TOOROUR FOREST AREA. STRATHBOGIE PLATEAU.  
 KEY TO PLACES OF INTEREST.

1. TOOROUR FOREST LODGE. Very comfortable accomm. Starting-point for walks and drives e.; Lima Creek & Leerson's Walks. Central to towns and places of interest. Bookings; Ph 611 611. (\$11.00 per night.)
  2. ROCKY NED WATERFALL. Picnic spots and lovely walks. Access by 4WD along Chinaman's Trk- 20mins.
  3. CRYSTAL MINES. Picnic spot. Tables etc. No toilets. Interesting to wander around fossicking. This area once largest producer in Sthn. Hemisphere. New enterprise operating.
  4. TALLANGALOOK, Old Gold-Mining Town. Vast open cuts, now filled with tree-ferns. Town once had P.O. Bank, Pub, & 800 residents. Now only remnant old fruit trees, ruined foundations. Picnic spots.
  5. GOLDEN MOUNT. Use either 4WD vehicle or walk the last 500 metres off Ferraris Track. Amazing views of Bonnie Doon, beautiful snow gums and rocks.
  6. MT. SEPARATION. Accessible from Toorour Lodge along forestry roads. Walk last few metres to see fabulous 360o views of the Alps. (Maps D & A.)
- POLLY McQUINN'S WATERHOLE. Access from Euroa or Strathbogie along Galls' Gap Road. Swimming.
- \*\*\*The places shown on this map are all approximately 20 mins drive from Toorour, and 40 - 45 mins. to all nearest towns - Euroa, Benalla, Merton, Violet Town & Swanpool. Allow extra time for looking around, walking, photography, picnics etc. There is too much to accomplish in one day. Forestry roads are not recommended in Winter.
