Strathbogie Forest News

There have been a lot of different activities taking place in the forest recently. There was a night walk led by Bert Lobert and Lance spotlighting. This was a great opportunity for people to see first hand some of the nocturnal animals that live in our forest. Some of the species observed were Greater Gliders, koalas, a powerful owl, ringtail possums amongst other species.

Then a photo day led by Michael Flatt was held and people from some different camera clubs came and spent a day taking photos in the forest.

And as reported last month, Victorian Minister for Agriculture Peter Walsh visited the Strathbogie For-

est to see first hand the damage to the forests and to listen to concerns. The Minister was accompanied by Member for Benalla, Bill Sykes and the National's candidate for the new seat of Euroa, Stephanie Ryan. Representing the Strathbogie Sustainable Forestry Alliance, Sim and Bert met up with the visitors in Strathbogie Township, car-pooled and then drove out to the forest. As there had previously been communications with the Minister, he was already partly informed of the views of the group. Minister Walsh was shown the type of forest that VicForests insists is sawlog harvesting, as well as the 'failed coupe', an example of what can happen when things go terribly wrong when logging mixed-species forest. The Minister. Bill and Steph listened to the concerns and participated in the discussion. It was outlined how the campaign to better manage Strathbogie Forests had begun; that it was the mis-management of Tolmie Forests to the east that generated the initial alarm. And once it was seen what VicForests was doing at Tolmie and their plans for Strathbogie, local people felt they had to act and become vocal advocates for Our Forest and all the values that these forests contain and the services they provide.

At the failed coupe, the group met up with Ron Jones, a Strathbogie resident who has lived and worked in these forests since the 1940's. Ron impressed on the visitors that current forest management was a direct threat to the forest and that if continued, the forest would only be producing pulp, not the sawlogs that VicForests insist are driving the local industry. Ron also pointed out that the large areas of even-aged stands would pose a significant wildfire-risk. Ron's support is invaluable; his credibility and experience give considerable weight to his opinions and the Strathbogie Forest group's position.

In true form, it started raining towards the end of the one-and-a-half-hour tour and discussions were wound up sheltering under umbrellas and finally

at the Strathbogie Store over a hot cuppa.

Since the Minister's visit, the Labor candidate Claire Malcom, and Greens Candidate Jenny O'Conner have also visited the forest.







STRATHBOGIE TABLELAND ACTION GROUP NEWS

Since its election, the new STAG committee has commenced planning a number of initiatives and activities:

- Work is underway to develop a plan to beautify the streetscape in the township. Further details will be available once the plan is complete.
- It is planned to run a basic first aid session for members of the community prior to Christmas. This will not be a certificate course but will cover issues such as CPR, snake bite, etc.
 - If sufficient persons are interested a Level 2 First Aid course may be run. This is a certificate course which would have a fee attached and would need a minimum of ten persons for it to proceed.
 - Dates are still to be finalised however it would be helpful if we could have an idea of numbers if you are interested in either course please advise Helen Peters on 5790 5236 or email helday3@bigpond.com.
- Several members of the STAG committee have been invited to join representatives from the other Action Groups across the Shire to meet with Councillors on 14th October. Details of discussions will be in the next issue of Tableland Talk.
- Our Roads Sub-committee has been communicating with Council on a number of issues:
 - the need for yellow lines on fog prone roads
 - the need for a central line on Spring Creek Road and Boundary Hill Road
 - the dangerous intersection at Creek Junction Road and Strathbogie Road
 - the use of Shire roads by logging trucks, in particular Bonnie Doon Road and Harrys Creek Road
- STAG is aware of log trucks using Bonnie Doon Road, Harrys Creek Road, Euroa/Strathbogie Road, Spring Creek Road and Tames Road with motorists have numerous "near misses". Our committee has questioned Council concerning:
 - the danger to motorists
 - the degradation to road surface
 - the fact that load limit on Harrys Creek Road has been lifted from 8 tonnes to 25 tonnes even though Coun cil is yet to be advised (as at 7 October) by the timber harvesters re volume of timber to be carried and truck types being used.

We urge all motorists to drive with the utmost care – if you have an issue with log trucks ring Council (Toll Free 1800 065 995) or write and lodge a complaint.
