My ill friend has managed to switch her mobile phone to Telstra so she can receive calls independently and she has learned how to read message to text. We also managed to program in caller ID on her phone so she can vet calls.

What has struck me, and been frustrating at times, is to watch my friend become increasingly isolated as her illness progresses. If she was able to use an iPad or laptop she could stay in touch with grandchildren and friends that live a long way away, or who may also be unwell. She could access medical information and resources. There was a recent crisis re treatment options and it took 3 people half an hour to write and send a text message! Whilst there are advantages to not being tech savvy (peace and quiet, time to self etc) this experience has made me think there are some very real benefits from learning how to use technology as we grow older. So saying, I encourage everyone to get with it! (me included)


